Gretchen congratulated Gael on a job well done and mentioned Gael's title is now financial officer to coincide with AAUW national.

Committee reports:

The program was a public meeting so membership was offered at half price through the Shape the Future Membership Campaign. Gifts and wrapping paper will be collected for the Interior Alaska Center for Non-Violent Living and members/guests are asked to bring a white elephant or other gift for our exchange, which is always popular. For January there will be an informal luncheon and Gretchen has made reservations at Lemon Grass, however other restaurants will also be considered. February's program will be Saturday, February 18, 11 am at
